For Full-Time Christian Ministry Leaders

It is our desire to be the school of choice for the children of Christian pastors and other full-time ministry leaders in Santa Barbara, California.

In recognition of our partnership and common goals, we are pleased to offer qualified ministry leaders a 25% discount on tuition at all grade levels.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Full-time pastors (ordained or not) of duly organized and established churches.
- Full-time executive leaders of Christian ministry organizations.
- Full-time faculty or staff of Westmont College.
- Alignment with the Providence School Statement of Faith, representing a historical, orthodox Christian position.

PROCESS:

- Apply for admission to Providence School:
 1. Speak with an admission representative (in-person campus tour preferred, but not required)
 2. Fill out an application and pay the application fee
 3. Submit previous school records (as applicable)
 4. Student is assessed for academic placement
 5. Family interview (casual conversation) with the head of school
- When an offer of admission is made, if eligible, the 25% discount will be applied. (Some restrictions apply, depending on family income/assets and number of students enrolling.)
- Should a family have need for additional tuition assistance, they are welcome to apply for aid via FACTS, a third-party tuition assistance needs-assessment organization (providencesb.org/tuition-assistance)

Statement of Faith

Statement on Scriptural Authority

WE BELIEVE that the Bible (both Old Testament and New Testament) is the divinely inspired and infallible Word of God, and that everything the Bible affirms to be true is true and everything the Bible affirms to be false is false, and that it is the supreme authority in all matters.

Statement on the Nature of God and Humankind

WE BELIEVE in one God, eternally existing in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Humankind is created in His image, creation and providence are revelatory of Him (Gen 1:26; Jn 1:1; Jn 10:33; Phil 2:9-11). Though created in His image, we believe in the fall and consequent total moral depravity of humanity, resulting in our exceeding sinfulness and lost estate, and necessitating our regeneration by the Holy Spirit.

Statement on Jesus Christ

WE BELIEVE that Jesus Christ is God manifested in the flesh, born of a virgin. He lived a sinless life, suffered and died on our behalf, arose bodily from the grave, ascended, and is coming again in power and glory.

Statement on the Holy Spirit

WE BELIEVE that God the Holy Spirit convicts us of sin, brings us to faith in Jesus Christ, and conforms us to the image of Christ. God the Holy Spirit regenerates and empowers his people to continue God's work, and for a life of holiness and service.

WE BELIEVE in the spiritual unity of believers in our Lord Jesus Christ.
